Greater Waterberg Complex Artisans are a group of men and women from five different conservancies around the Waterberg Plateau Park, including Ozonahi, African Wild Dog, Otjituuo, Okamatapati and the Waterberg Conservancy, which making up the Greater Waterberg Landscape.

The Greater Waterberg Complex has a vision to restore a wildlife base and develop alternate sources of income through an integrated conservancy programme. CCF, a research centre within the GWC is helping build capacity within the communities through workshops teaching high quality craftsmanship, cultural tourism, integrated livestock, wildlife and land management, eventually leading to wildlife reintroductions in the area.


Traditional Children's Thongs
